

## How does our Bond Issue compare with districts around us?

This table below depicts six surrounding districts;  
 ...which have passed levies and completed **OSFC** building projects:  
**Allen East, Lima City, and Spencerville;**  
 ...Passed levies and are preparing to build: **Kalida,**  
 ...Have levies presently on the ballot: **St. Marys,**  
 ...Have defeated levies and declined **OSFC** projects and have become a lapsed district: **Columbus Grove.**

***The millage requested by Wapakoneta, 5.80, is below the 6.73 mill average for the other six schools.*** This lower millage is achieved even after considering Wapakoneta's higher local percentage, 37%, compared to the group's average local share of 25%.

***Wapakoneta is requesting almost 1 mill less (6.73 - 5.80) than the average request, despite paying 12% (37% -25%) more than the group average for our local portion.***

**Our local school buildings will be constructed at just less than half the average millage of the group, 3.34 mills compared to 6.73 mills.**
